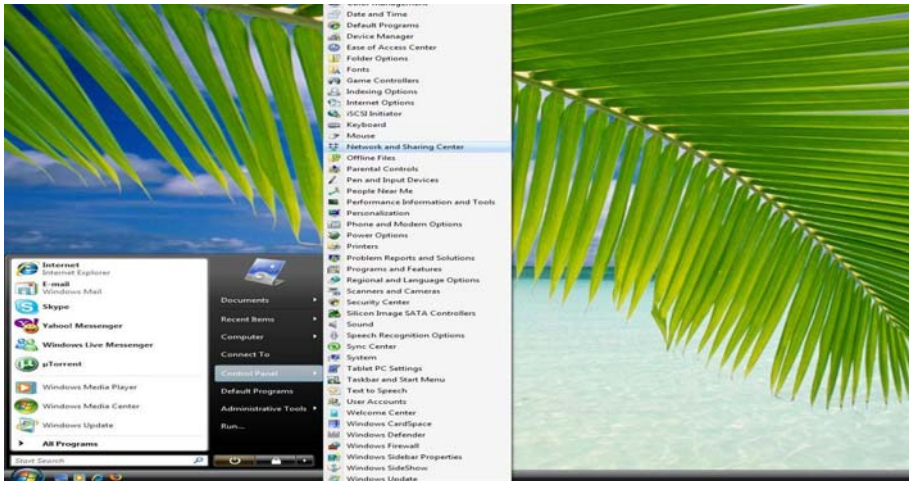


# Configuring Windows Vista for Dial Up

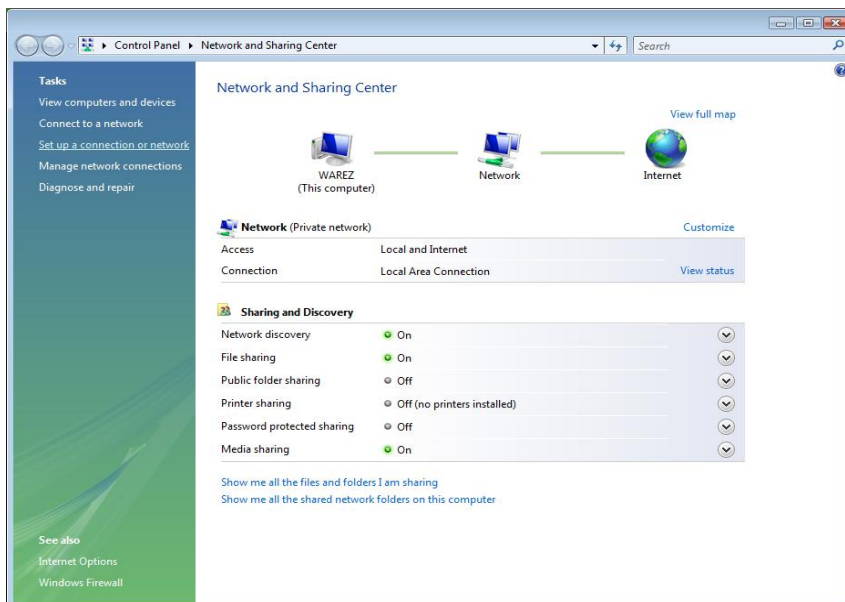
## Step 1

Click on the **Start Orb** and select the **Control Panel** option. Then select **Network and Sharing Center**.



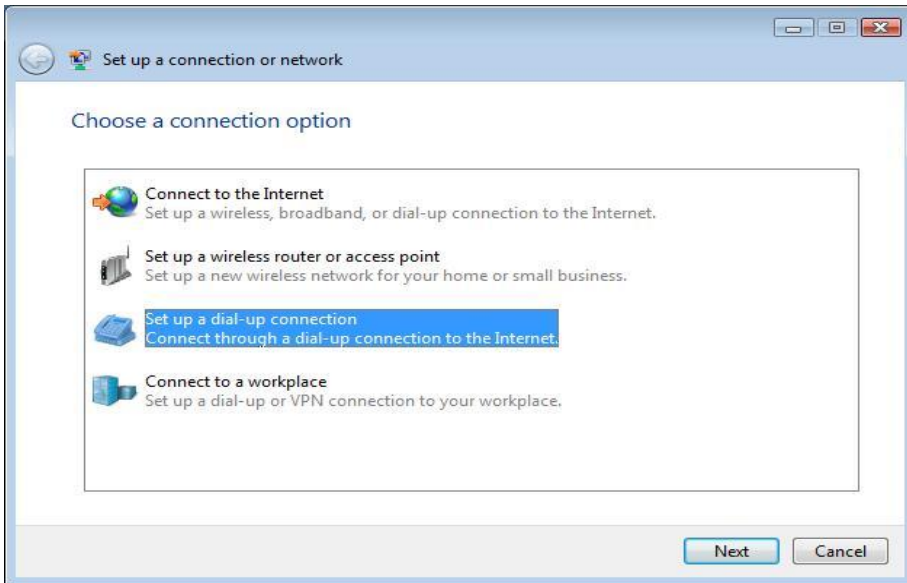
## Step 2

In the window that opens select the **Set up a connection or network** option on the left-hand side.



### Step 3

Select the option **Set up a dial-up connection**, to do this make sure the option is highlighted in blue. Click **Next**.



### Step 4

Enter the following information:

Kinect dial up number, **086777770** into the telephone number field.

You will need to enter your **username** and **password** for you Kinect dial up connection (selected by you at sign up).

The **Remember this password** option should be checked.

In the Connection name field enter **Kinect**.

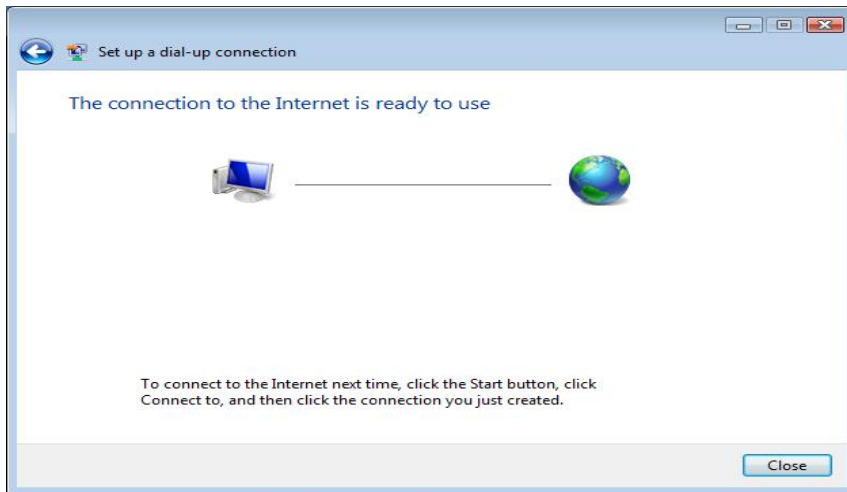
Click **Create**.

**NB:** If you want to select the 'Allow other people to use this connection' option, you will need to have administrative rights on their machine, and press **Continue** on the User Account Control screen.



## **Step 6**

The new dial-up account has been created.



## **Shortcut for Windows Vista**

Creating a shortcut means that an icon will be added to your desktop which you can double click on to start your internet connection.

Click on **Start Orb > Control Panel > Network and Sharing Center > Manage Network Connections**

This will open a new window. Click on the **Kinect** icon once to highlight it, and then right click on the icon. This will open another menu list and then select **create shortcut** and click on this with the left mouse button.

An error message will then pop up which will say 'Windows can not create a shortcut here do you want the shortcut to be placed on the desktop'. Select **yes**.

Close all the windows that have been opened by clicking on the X in the top right hand corner. You should now be able to see a shortcut to Kinect icon on your desktop.
