Step 1

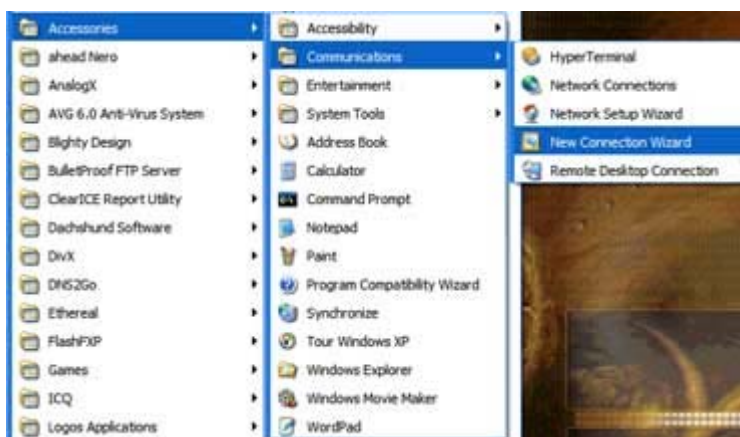
Click **Start**

Select **All Programs**



Select **Accessories -> Communications**

Select **Setup my connection manually**
Click **Next**




Step 5
